

Green Dot High School Training Policies & Agreements

TEAM ATTENDANCE

To maximize the potential for real change in a high school, a team approach to Green Dot is required. If you are coming from a school that is already implementing Green Dot, you are welcome to attend the training solo or with other team members. If your school is new to Green Dot, we require a team of at least 2-3 participants, with a strong recommendation for teams of 5 to 10. One person cannot single-handedly create the sustained changes that an issue like power-based personal violence prevention requires. We recommend that team members include not only designated prevention/intervention staff, but also professionals across your institution like faculty, guidance staff, and administrators.

I have read and understand the expectations for team attendance. If attending solo, I confirm that there are already trained instructors in my school. If there are not already trained instructors in my school, I confirm that I am attending with more than one person from my school.

GREEN DOT IMPLEMENTATION

Only high school personnel can implement the Green Dot strategy in their school. Community-based agencies can serve as partners, but cannot implement Green Dot in a school without trained, school-based personnel. A team approach is necessary. For the high school strategy, you will need more than one person trained to implement.

PROGRAM TRAINING POLICY

Each version of the Green Dot strategy is designed to reach a specific target population. This track will enable participants to implement the Green Dot strategy only in the high school setting. This training will not equip you to implement the Green Dot strategy with any populations other than high school.

TRAINING ATTENDANCE POLICY

You must attend the entire training each day to become a Green Dot High School instructor.

INSTRUCTOR POLICY

Upon completion of the training you will be a Green Dot Instructor. This means that you can implement the Green Dot Violence Prevention Strategy with your target population, but does NOT mean that you can train other individuals or groups to implement the strategy.



GREEN DOT COMMUNITY USAGE AGREEMENT

This Usage Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into immediately, by and between ALTERISTIC INC., a Virginia not-for-profit corporation, having its principal office at 7955 Cameron Brown Ct., Springfield, VA 22153 ("Alteristic"), and myself.

I agree to adhere to the following guidelines.

- 1. Upon completion of the Instructor Certification training, Alteristic grants you a non-exclusive, fee-free, revocable license agreement to use the Green Dot program's trademarks in your community. You are also granted a non-exclusive, revocable license to use Green Dot copyrighted materials. The instructor training certifies you to implement the Green Dot for High School program for your organization and institution. You are not certified to train others to implement the program. You are not certified to implement the Green Dot strategy in settings other than high school.
- 2. Only individuals who have received the Green Dot instructor training from certified trainers may present the curricular components of the program.
- 3. You MAY NOT alter the Green Dot curriculum in any way, except where specified within the materials for adaptation purposes.
- 4. The Green Dot curriculum must be implemented in its entirety and independently (i.e., may not be broken into pieces or integrated into other specific programming strategies).
- 5. Your training manuals may NOT be duplicated for any reason. Any program materials (including electronic materials and implementation kit items) may be disseminated for program implementation purposes only. Only the original recipient is authorized to utilize Green Dot materials.
- 6. All Green Dot designs may be used to create materials for use within your social marketing campaign. Designs and Green Dot materials developed may not be sold or distributed for a profit. Please note that all profits from Green Dot gear that is ordered directly from the official Alteristic store is used for scholarships and costs associated with running the organization and providing training.
- 7. With respect to the use of Alteristic's Green Dot trademarks, you agree that you will use your best efforts and due diligence to use our trademarks properly and in such a way as to not negatively affect the value of our trademarks.
- 8. Either party may terminate this Agreement and the right to use Alteristic's Green Dot trademarks and copyrighted materials by providing 30 days' notice to the other party in writing.



- 9. Violation of any of these terms of usage can be considered a default of the license to use Alteristic's Green Dot trademarks and materials, and Alteristic may terminate this license and Usage Agreement immediately upon notice to you.
- 10. If this Agreement expires or is terminated for any reason, your right to continue using Alteristic's Green Dot trademarks shall immediately end. In the event of Termination, you shall be obligated to immediately cease any further use of the Green Dot trademarks and cease any further use of the Green Dot programs, materials, and curriculum, including Alteristic's Green Dot copyrighted materials.
- 11. As the Green Dot program is evaluated, content improvements will be made. Instructors can expect an updated version of the strategy every 1-3 years. These updates will be available to all previously-trained instructors. Electronic updates will be no cost. Hard copy updates will incur cost.
- 12. You may not charge fees or collect payment for delivering any portion of the Green Dot curriculum, including but not limited to the overview talk, bystander training, social marketing campaign, or action events.
- 13. No part of the Green Dot curriculum can be used as a disciplinary measure. All content must be delivered as prescribed in the launch plan.
